Verse 12 should only be used during Liturgy of the Hours.

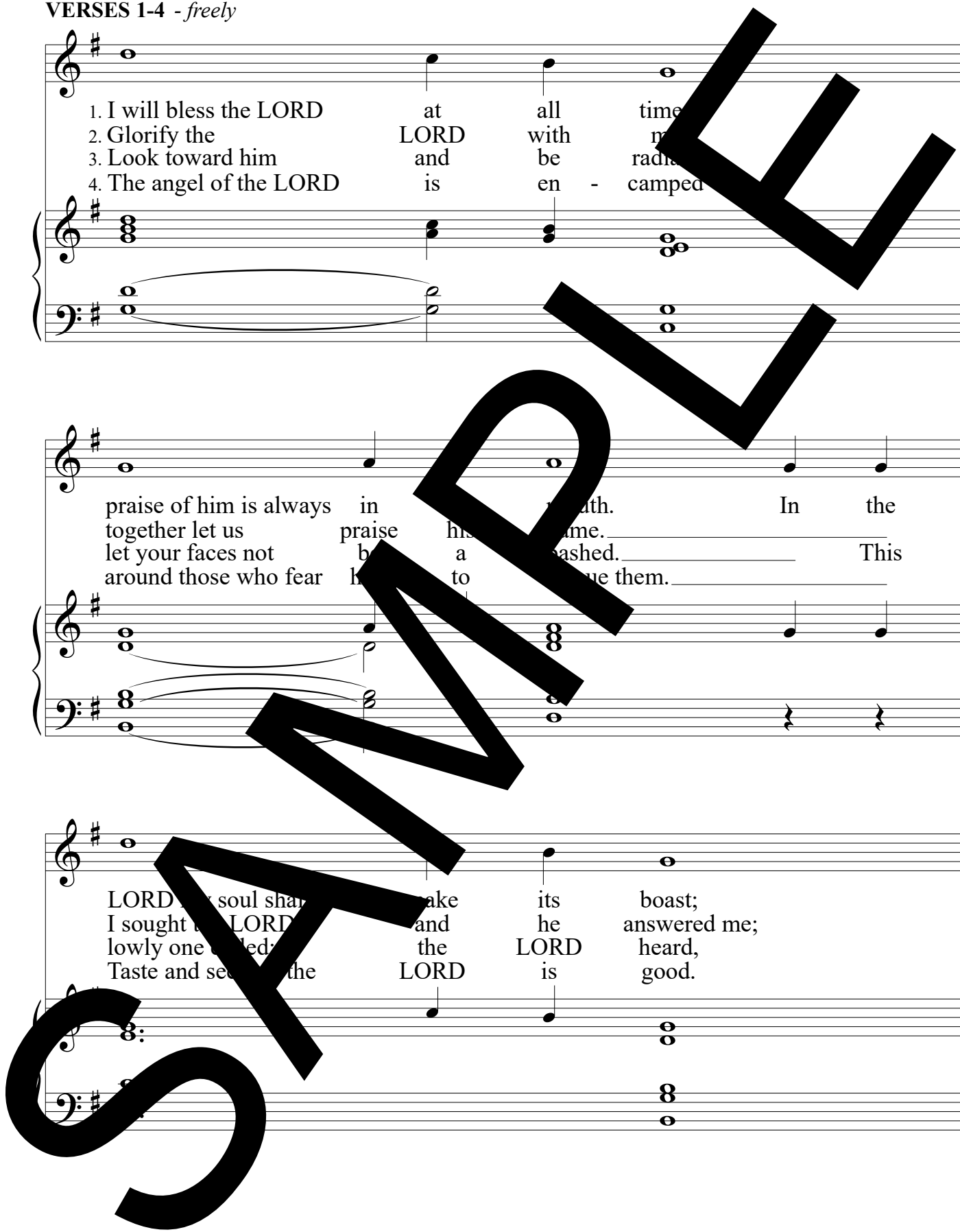
